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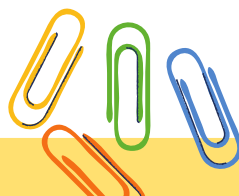
Elementary Summer Program

K CAMP

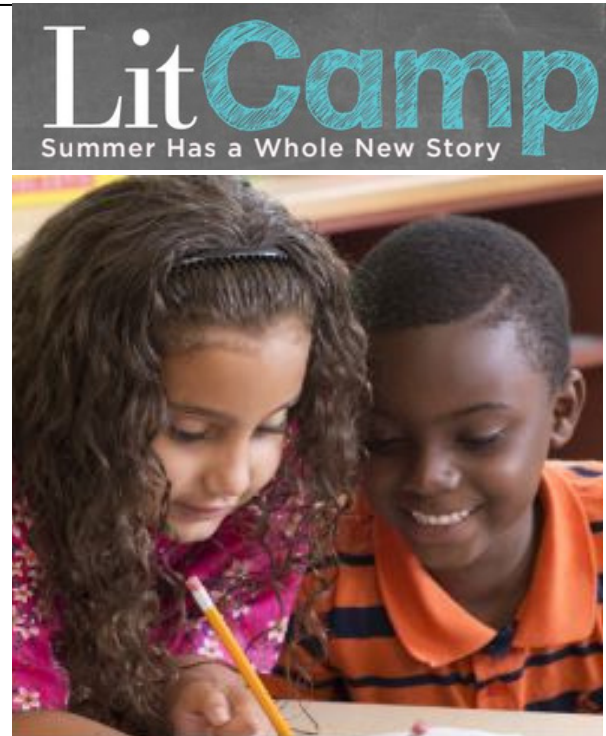

SUMMER PROGRAM: READING - LIT CAMP

LitCamp has students spend their days reading, talking, writing, learning, and enjoying songs, games, and other activities together. High interest books are read and discussed. The program also incorporates the 7 strengths into all lessons: Belonging, Friendship, Kindness, Curiosity, Courage, Confidence, and Hope.



SUMMER PROGRAM: SEL

Students participate in SEL (social emotional learning) activities during the day.

Themes during the program include empathy, friendship, emotions, impulse control, compassion, conflict resolution, and responsibility.

STUDENTS CAN ATTEND ELA AND MATH CLASSES, AS WELL AS CAMP INVENTION CLASSES, SEL ACTIVITIES, AND CAMP EAGLE FOR PHYSICAL GAMES. THE PROGRAM RUNS FROM 7/11-8/18 FROM MONDAY TO THURSDAY, FROM 8:30-2:30PM AT THE JHS.

STUDENTS IN GRADE 6-8 CAN ATTEND A SIX WEEK CREDIT RECOVERY SUMMER PROGRAM, IF THEY DID NOT PASS A CORE CLASS. GRADE 6 CREDIT RECOVERY IS HELD IN THE JHS, GRADES 7-8 IS HELD AT THE HS.

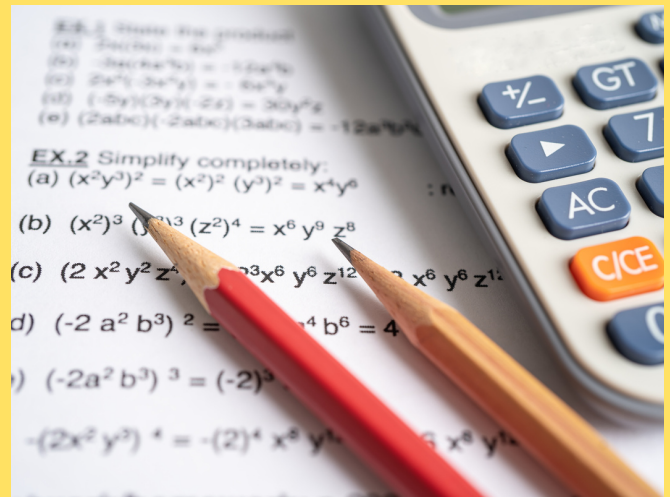

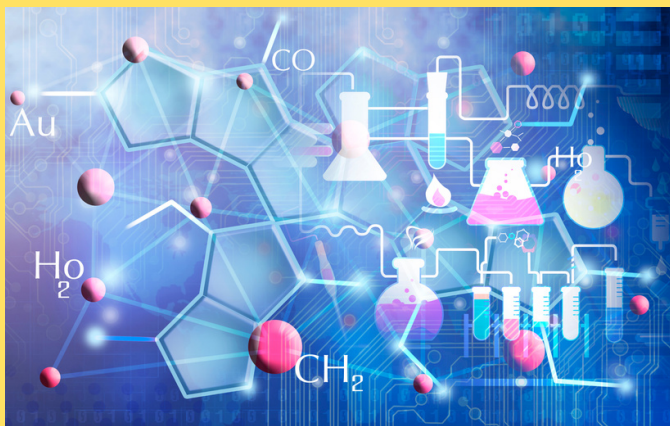
