Mr. Cacciola thanked the West Babylon community for coming out to support the budget. He said that the budget passed by a 67% margin, which is the highest the district has experienced in most recent years. He also welcomed incoming trustees Lucy Campasano, Stacy Villagran and Jennifer Wandasiewicz and thanked outgoing trustees Patrick Farrell, Carmine Galletta and Kathleen Jennings for their many years of service to the Board of Education and the West Babylon community.

Superintendent's Report/Educational Presentation:

Math and Science Program Evaluation — Patricia Acocella and Stephen O'Leary

Dr. Palma introduced the chairpeople and explained that this will be the last program evaluation done in this format; the district will be using the new format for all future evaluations. Mrs. Acocella thanked the community for passing the budget which will benefit both the children and the West Babylon community. She thanked the outgoing trustees and welcomed the incoming trustees. She and Mr. O'Leary reviewed the program evaluations. In response to Mr. Cacciola's question, Mrs. Acocella said that having staff development as early in the year as possible two days at a time for grade K-2 and two for grades 3-5 would be the best solution to pulling staff out of the classrooms during the later part of the year. Dr. Palma explained that the resolution to adopt the new books will be on the next agenda. He explained that the books for grades 3-5 are hardcover and will be used for years and the books for grades K-2 are consumable and will be replaced annually. Mr. O'Leary said he is confident that all state ed. requirements are being met and the program is well rounded. He said that advanced placement is being opened to more students than ever. He said that he doesn't feel that the common core changes will be as large at the high school level. The chairpeople agreed that the common core will assist in blending between the buildings. In response to trustee DeGaetano's question, Mr. O'Leary said that the departments will work with the guidance counselors to encourage students (and inform parents) to take the advanced placement courses and explain the benefits. In response to trustee Thiel's question, Mr. O'Leary said that Dr. Vassallo has a proposal and a draft application for a Math Honor Society. Mr. Cacciola thanked Mrs. Acocella and Mr. O'Leary for all that they are doing and said he is grateful that they were willing to accept the challenge of the new chairperson model. He said it is working due to the dedication of the staff.
