Mr. Anthony Cacciola introduced the presentation and the Intel Club Advisors, Ms. Kristina Waldeck and Mr. Christopher Jonasson. The competition is held on a Long Island level through to the National level. Our district competed in the Behavioral Science division. Ms. Waldeck and Mr. Jonasson introduced Andrew Battifarano and Raymond Schein. The students presented their project and results. Approximately 400 students in all grade levels (100 students in each level grades 9-12) were tested/surveyed and the results indicate that sports have a positive impact on grades. Trustee Patrick Farrell thanked the students for the presentation and commended them on a job well done.
