SMART Schools Bond

Overview

- In the November 2014 general election, the voters approved a \$2 billion dollar capital bond for the purposes of increasing educational technology, and expanding classroom space for pre-kindergarten and high tech security
- \$3,059,663 West Babylon
 - There is no expiration on these funds
 - The investment plan must be submitted and approved by SED
 - The submissions need to follow all capital guidelines
 - The funding is based on a reimbursement model

SMART Schools Bond

Allowable use for these funds includes:

- Purchasing educational technology equipment and facilities, such as interactive whiteboards, computer servers, desktop and laptop computers, tablets and high-speed broadband or wireless internet
- Installing high-tech security features in school buildings
- The following items are required, but not allowable use for these funds:
 - We are required to meet the 100 mg per 1,000 student bandwidth requirement
 - This will cost approximately \$40,000 re-occurring beginning in the 2016-2017 budget
 - Professional Development and personnel to provide on-going technical support must be included in the plan

- All main entrances to each school building will be outfitted with Double Secured Vestibules including:
 - Camera(s)
 - Buzzer entry
 - Document pass through
 - Door replacement or refurbishment
 - Intercom
- Approved Letter of Intent \$315,506

Phase II Process

- The District Wide Security Committee along with Intralogic Security Systems reviewed high tech solutions.
- The Double Secured Vestibules and stage one access are the first steps in this enhancement.

Phase III: Enhanced Security Features

- Enhanced Security Features including
 - Additional cameras
 - One-button lockdown
 - Strobe lights
 - Door access
- Review and improvements on the PA System
 - Integration with Security Enhancements
 - Review of existing coverage and additions to ensure full PA coverage
