Grades K - 5:

To enter, submit an original 8" X 10" page **drawing** that can be colored in. It must be about Safety around Trains and Tracks (one entry per student) using "Safety Along The Tracks" as the theme.

Grades 6 - 8:

To enter, **create** an 8" X 10" page Crossword Puzzle or find a Word Search, about Safety around Trains and Tracks (one entry per student) using "Safety Along The Tracks" as the theme.

Grades 9 – 12:

To enter, **create** content on one 8" X 10" page, such as games, puzzles, quizzes, pictures to color about Safety around Trains and Track (one entry per student) using "Safety Along The Tracks" as the theme.

Entries must be e-mailed to tracks@lirr.org using “**School Safety Activity Book Contest**” in the subject line and must include the School’s name / Teacher’s name, Student’s name, address, and daytime phone number.

LONG ISLAND RAIL ROAD “SAFETY ALONG THE TRACKS” SAFETY CONTEST 2022-2023

- 1. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY.** Contests runs on or about October 15th through December 15th, 2022. Contest is open to full-time elementary, middle and high school students. To enter Safety Activity Book Contest – **Grades K - 5**, the student will create a drawing that can be colored in. Drawing must be about Safety around Trains and Tracks. **Grades 6 - 8**, the student will create a Crossword Puzzle or Word Search that must be in Microsoft Word format with the subject of “LIRR Safety Activity Book”. **Grades 9 - 12**, the student will create an activity, puzzle or picture to color. To submit a contest entry, email your entries to: tracks@lirr.org with the subject “School Safety Activity Book”, your School Name, School Address, Phone Number, Grade, and Teacher’s Name. Grades 6 - 12 students must also include a Full Name, Address and Daytime Phone Number, including Area Code. All entries must be received by **December 15, 2022**.
2. Winning entries for all grade levels will be added to our new Safety Activity Book. This will be distributed at our T.R.A.C.K.S. programs and at Safety Events. The winner(s) will be selected by the Long Island Rail Road. The decision of the Long Island Rail Road is final. Mutilated or illegible entries will be disqualified. Winner(s) will be notified by the Long Island Rail Road by telephone / email by January, 2023. Winner(s) must respond back to Long Island Rail Road within 72 hours or an alternate winner(s) will be chosen.
3. Limit one entry per person. The Long Island Rail Road disclaims liability for late, lost, misdirected or stolen entries.
4. Entry constitutes agreement that entrants’ names, photographs and likenesses may be used for promotional purposes without additional compensation.
5. Participants must be students and provide proof of school attendance and identity will be required. It is the winners’ responsibility to provide proper proof. Employees of the MTA, LIRR, and their parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, and their immediate families are not eligible. Winner(s) will be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility and release. Failure to execute and return the affidavit and release within 5 calendar days from receipt thereof, shall result in disqualification from the contest and an alternate(s) winner will be chosen.
6. Winner(s) waive any and all claims of liability against the MTA, LIRR and their parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, representatives and employees from any loss or injuries arising from or related to this contest or acceptance of the prize(s), including but not limited to, liability for lost, late and /or misdirected mail and printing, typographical or other errors. By entering this contest, entrants hereby agree to be bound by these official rules. All entries become property of the Long Island Rail Road.
7. Void where prohibited or restricted by law.
8. In case of duplicate entries, the first entry received will be deemed the winner.
