Dr. Farrelly wished everyone a happy new school year. She welcomed New Trustee Mr. John Evola.

Dr. Farrelly said that the new graduation schedules went well and she was happy that the rain held off.

She noted that the Board will need to hold a special meeting on July 28 at 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of appointing personnel to replace those who have retired. Dr. Farrelly said that the Capital Project construction has officially begun. Mrs. Psarakis shared photos of the work that has started at the JHS. She asked the trustees if anyone plans to attend the NYSSBA conference from October 18-20. She said that the conference is from Sunday until Tuesday this year. Board President Lucy Campasano was disappointed that the conference is being held Sunday-Tuesday instead over a weekend as it has been in the past. She said the mid-week dates make it difficult for those who work to attend the conference. In addition, it would take the Superintendent away from the district during the school week. A single violation of PL220 will be a sufficient basis for filing a "PINS" petition."; Pg. 28 "Visitors to the schools" #1 added "current", #2 changed "office of the principal" to "designated area" and added "present identification", Public Conduct on School Property added "parents, community members and other visitors". There was a discussion about how the code of conduct is shared with the district. The entire code is on the website and an abridged version is mailed to parents in the summer.
