#### Statement of the Superintendent and/or Board of Education:

Dr. Farrelly proposed a change in next year's BOE meeting dates — she suggested changing the May 10th BOE meeting to May 3rd to allow the district and the post office more time to process the 6 day budget notice. The Board was in agreement.

Dr. Farrelly said that the district had bid openings on Thursday June 4th for the JHS piping, JHS & JFK VAT tiles, JFK site work and on Monday, June 8th a bid opening for the JHS turf field. Our architects and construction managers are vetting the lowest bidders. We expect to award the bids at the June 23rd BOE meeting.

Every year NYAPT Chapters holds a poster contest for students across various grade levels. Mr. Bianco forwards this information to all the art teachers. This year Jennifer Tomeo, JHS art teacher, had her students participate in this contest. The theme was "Bully Free Zone". The art work was outstanding. Highlights: Shared the areas of the Audit Emphasis including; audit planning; review and testing of audit controls; management's corrective actions for prior findings; findings of internal auditors; test of significant account balances; substantive test of expenditures by functions/programs; restricted reserves activities; amounts and presentation of financial statements including the full accrual; GASB 34 Financial statements; review of the capital assets inventory reports, including beginning balances, current year additions, disposals, and depreciation; calculation and presentation of long term liabilities including compensated absences, OPEB liabilities, installment purchase debt and workers' compensation; and if applicable, federal single audit compliance requirements.
