3. REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT AND/OR EDUCATIONAL PRESENTATION

Discussion, Presentation: A. Federal Grants Spending Proposal: Dr. Yiendhy Farrelly, Superintendent of Schools & Mr. Scott Payne, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum & Instruction

Dr. Farrelly introduced Mr. Payne who reviewed the PowerPoint presentation titled "West Babylon School District APR (American Rescue Plan) Funds".

A Zoom meeting was held earlier in the day with Dr. Farrelly and Mr. Payne. The meeting was designed to get feedback from West Babylon School District stakeholders regarding recent money granted by the Federal Government and NYSED. These grants have been awarded to NYS school districts to address the difficulties associated with the COVID-19 Pandemic as it pertains to K-12 education.

West Babylon School District was awarded \$4,609,272 under the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021 to be used over the 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24 school years. Additionally, West Babylon School District was also awarded approximately 3.48 million dollars under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSA Act) to be used over the 2021-22 & 2022-23 school years.

Mr. Payne shared that there are five different ARP Grant Projects areas as indicated below:

Discussion was held regarding summer school requirements; availability of social workers during the summer and during the 21-22 school year; and academic support. Mr. Payne said students are only required to go to summer school if they failed a course. Dr. Farrelly indicated social workers will be available during the summer school program and the 21-22 school year. Job postings are now out and the interview process will begin relative to hiring additional social workers so they can push into classes. We will have a staff of 2 social workers at the SHS instead of 1; at the elementary level, there will be 1 social worker for 2.5 buildings; and additional support at the JHS as well. Academic support is by invite, but all students/parents were invited to participate. The presentation will be posted to the website.
