WHEREAS, the SEQRA Regulations declare Type II Actions to be actions that have no significant impact on the environment and require no further review under SEQRA; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education, as the only involved agency, has examined all information related to the project and has determined, based upon the recommendation from Energia, in connection with its review and examination of the project, that the energy performance project is classified as a Type II Action pursuant to Section 617.5(c) (2) and (3) of the SEQRA Regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby declares itself as the lead agency in connection with the requirements of the State Environmental Quality Review Act; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby declares that the energy performance project is a Type II Action, which requires no further review under SEQRA; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby shall forward an official copy of this Resolution to the New York State Education Department together with a copy of the correspondence from the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation in connection with its request for approval of the project from the New State Education Department.

WHEREAS, the results of the ESG CEA have been reviewed and evaluated by the School District's consultant engineer, Energia, and the School District Administration to determine which comprehensive energy efficient technologies can realistically reduce the District's energy consumption and generate cost savings to the District; and

WHEREAS, based upon said review and evaluation of the CEA, Energia and the School District Administration have identified and recommend the scope of energy conservation measures to be installed in District Facilities pursuant to an Energy Performance Contract; and

WHEREAS, the School District Board desires to enter into an Energy Performance Contract for the installation of energy performance measures with ESG based upon the legal review and approval of the Energy Performance Contract. **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education hereby approves the scope and the installation of

energy performance measures and energy conservation services in District Facilities; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby authorizes the Board President to execute an Energy Performance Contract between the School District and ESG that incorporates the energy conservation services and installations that are identified in the 2 Energy Performance Contract and all supporting documents, as recommended and approved by the School District counsel and Energia.
