Dr. Farrelly thanked the community for joining. She informed the community this week was School Counselor and PTA Recognition Week. On behalf of the Board of Education and Administration Team, she thanked all Guidance Counselors for supporting students like they do. She also thanked the PTA Committees for their partnerships and support.

Dr. Farrelly further advised that as part of the Suffolk County Schools Superintendent's Association, the Legislative Committee has identified and begun to advocate for certain priorities. Superintendents have been meeting with elected officials from Long Island to highlight legislative priorities; some of which are quite similar to NYS School Boards Association, PTAs and other advocacy groups. Their ask has been:

- For the state to fully fund foundation aid. As per the Governor's School Aid Runs released last week, she informed this appears to be the case.
- · For the state to fund Universal Free Breakfast and Lunch program for our students.
- A complete change to the current APPR legal requirement. The ask is to allow school districts to develop their evaluation system for their teachers and principals locally.
- Increased and flexibility in the funding for Universal Pre-Kindergarten
- Extension to the zero emission buses timeline requirements. The current statewide requirement is that all school districts must purchase and lease only zero emission buses by 2035. Dr. Farrelly indicated this was fraught with challenges. One of many roadblocks is that school districts and the county do not have the infrastructure (ie charging stations) or funding immediately needed for this.
- Lastly, she mentioned a Civil Service reform. There are many antiquated rules and regulations that cause unnecessary burden and interfere with the ability to expeditiously recruit and hire qualified employees for essential positions.
