Dr. Farrelly thanked the community for joining. Dr. Farrelly shared that Mr. Hanley led a recognition ceremony to honor the district's retirees. On behalf of the Board of Education and the administration team, Dr. Farrelly extended best wishes to all retirees for a happy and healthy retirement. She also expressed appreciation to Mr. Hanley and Mrs. Bruckner for coordinating the details of this annual retirement program.

Dr. Farrelly also addressed a concern brought forward by a resident during the June 10th Board of Education meeting. The concern involved individuals gathering at the Junior High School track, near the benches and the old press box. As she explained, residents are permitted to use the field and track outside of school hours. Additionally, club teams are allowed to rent district facilities in accordance with the district's facility use policy. At present, a club team is authorized to use the field on Saturdays and Sundays. This team pays the appropriate fees, which include compensation for custodial services to clean the area after use.

Dr. Farrelly noted that several actions have already been taken by the Buildings and Grounds Department in response:

- District benches have been temporarily relocated and will be returned when the season begins.
- The gate on the Joan Place access point will now be locked at sundown.
- Portable restrooms with 24/7 access have been placed on the field.
- Track and field equipment has been removed.

3. REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT AND/OR EDUCATIONAL PRESENTATION

Presentation, Recognition: A. Recognition - Book Signing, Angie Rosenberger, Junior High School Student

Dr. Farrelly shared that it was with great pride that the final Board of Education meeting of the school year concluded by recognizing several outstanding members of the student body.

She noted that this meeting celebrated a student author from the district as well as a remarkable group of student-athletes who achieved the highest level of success in high school athletics by qualifying for state-level competition.

Dr. Farrelly expressed her joy in introducing Miss Rosenberger, author of *The Case of the Dog Ate My Homework*, who was accompanied by Mr. Rosenberger. Dr. Farrelly mentioned that she had purchased copies of the book to present to the Board of Education and central administration team, and had invited the author to join the meeting to personally sign the books.

Before presenting the books, Dr. Farrelly invited Miss Rosenberger to share a summary of her work with those in attendance.

On behalf of the Board of Education and the administration team, Dr. Farrelly expressed how proud they are of Miss Rosenberger and how excited they are to support her as she continues her writing journey.

Presentation: B. Districtwide State Student Athlete Recognition, Dr. Yiendhy Farrelly, Superintendent of Schools & Mr. Robert Panariello, Interim Director of Health, Physical Education & Athletics

Following Miss Rosenberger's presentation, Dr. Farrelly recognized an exceptional group of students — the district's student-athletes who qualified for state-level competition in track and field, gymnastics, independent swimming, and wrestling.

She shared that reaching this level of competition requires far more than just talent. It demands relentless dedication, early mornings and late nights, an unwavering work ethic, and the resilience to push through setbacks, injuries, and intense pressure. Dr. Farrelly also acknowledged the critical role played by families, teammates, and coaches, whose ongoing support has been essential to each athlete's journey.

She commended the students for demonstrating what it truly means to be "all in" — setting ambitious goals and working tirelessly to achieve them. These athletes have not only excelled in their respective sports, but have also balanced their responsibilities in the classroom and served as leaders within the school community.

At this point, Dr. Farrelly invited Mr. Panariello to the microphone to address the Board of Education and the student-athletes.

On behalf of the West Babylon School District — including the Board of Education, staff, and the proud families in attendance — Dr. Farrelly offered heartfelt congratulations. She emphasized that these students have inspired their peers, brought pride to the community, and set an example that will encourage others to dream big and pursue their goals with determination.

However, as a community we continue to find a way through it. We are in no way, shape or form a perfect admin team, a perfect superintendent, perfect teacher, a perfect principal, perfect board, all of the above, community. However we all care, we reflect .. we maintain our focus on our children while making necessary district,

difficult decisions. I genuinely cannot thank veryone enough for working together, for supporting one another to as we navigate our district forward through the challenges, district goals, needs and wants. I am truly honored to close out the school year and open up a new one .. focusing steadfast on our goals, priorities, shared communication and strategic planning so that we can continue to stead our district together as that is the only way to continue to move forward. So I do appreciate everyone's time, everyone's effort, hard work and everyone's dedication. As we close out this year and we begin the next one. 25-26 here we go!"
